

## ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

When evaluating impact on the environment, several factors need to be considered by Management and employees.

Our trade has the potential to have a severe impact on the environment through water and waste management. Efficient work practices will eliminate this potential.

- Minimise waste by using natural resources efficiently.
- Recycle waste whenever possible.
- Provide clients with advice and guidance regarding rainwater tank installations, grey and recycled water systems.
- Protect water systems from contamination.
- Inform management if you encounter an existing illegal stormwater connection.
- Carry out testing on Backflow Prevention Devices as per regulatory requirements.
- Inform clients' of measures to assist in the reduction of environmental impact.
- Contain spills immediately to minimise the impact.
- Ensure motor vehicles are serviced and running at peak efficiency to minimise pollutants.
- Compliance is required to laws and regulations concerning the environment.

Management encourages employees to comment and recommend strategies to reduce environmental impact. Strategies already in place will be monitored for effectiveness and possible improvement. The policy shall be reviewed annually (September each year) to ascertain regulatory compliance and effectiveness.

The environmental target has been set by Management at ZERO, records relating to systems of work will be assessed and signed off by supervisory personnel to verify compliance at the completion of each job. Any non-compliance identified will be reviewed by Management and strategies implemented to ensure compliance to environmental regulations.
